EDST 540 B, Locating Oneself in Global Learning, Part II (Online course) requires a Project Assistant to assist the Instructor with delivering the course. This is a required course in the MEd in Adult Learning and Global Change (ALGC) program. The course will begin on February 15, 2012 and end on April 30, 2012. The project assistant will lead small group discussions within the course, comprised of students from the four partner universities, and assist with marking and other course-related matters as determined by the Instructor. Applicants will be admitted to candidacy (Doctorate preferred) in adult education or closely related area; have experience with online learning using the **It's Learning** platform; be knowledgeable of, and understand the literature on individual and global learning, particularly the curricular framework of a capability envelope. The rate of pay for this position is \$264.68 per student in the discussion group to a maximum of \$5293.60.
